

16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement

The Government has introduced the 16 to 19 tuition fund which is a £96 million of one-off funding for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Our share of this funding is £4,505

How the College will use the 16 to 19 tuition fund

The 16 to 19 tuition fund will be used to provide small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 who have had their learning disrupted. The provision will not be limited to tuition for English and maths but will also be used to help progressing students on other academic subjects. Students with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) - who require additional tuition to help them catch up with their studies - will also be supported by this provision.

Tuition groups will comprise of no more than five students and the tuition sessions will be scheduled in addition to the planned programme of study hours already timetabled for the academic year 2020/21. Tuition and additional support may be delivered using a blend of online and onsite delivery.
